What is the congregation's or organization's vision for ministry:

The vision of ministry for the First Presbyterian Church of Greensboro is to be the church of choice for the rapidly growing active adult community in the Greene County area. We energetically invite prospective members to join us in worship and we welcome visitors warmly. We endeavor to provide a meaningful worship experience, which stimulates the mind and soul through music and the reading and interpretation of scripture, with suggestions for application of our faith in our modern world. Individually, and as a community, we strive to be a beacon of hope and love.

How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

We have identified two basic emerging needs of our community. The first is care of the expanding population of older residents. Declining health, separation from family and the need for fellowship are concerns of this group that go beyond basic worship experiences. The second need is support for the economically disadvantaged population. We attempt to meet these needs with programs such as classroom mentoring, working with youth organizations, visiting and providing worship activities in nursing and rehabilitation facilities, and volunteering with and financially supporting food and clothing banks and Habitat for Humanity. Beyond this local mission work, First Greensboro provides funds and needed items for general World Missions and, specifically, to "Orphan Aid Liberia."

- By providing inspiration and momentum for action through meaningful worship
- By being a role model for community service in a community of varied economic and social situations
- By using community-building skills to enhance the bonds of the church family
- By providing dedicated pastoral care of the congregation
- By playing a significant role in growing the membership of the congregation through evangelical efforts in the active adult communities of the area and providing a warm welcome to all visitors

Provide a description of the characteristics needed by the person who is open to being called to this congregation and or organization:

Of foremost importance will be the ability to lead worship services including the presentation of meaningful sermons and demonstrating through spiritual maturity the joyful love of God, His Word and His people. This person will need to be compassionate in the relationship with members of the congregation, as well as with the larger community. Insight and knowledge to aid the church's involvement with the active adult community will be important. This may require inspired vision and the seeking as well as giving of guidance. Similarly, involvement with the larger local community will require understanding and willingness to work with persons from other economic and social situations. Intellectual and social skills will be of great importance. Also of great importance will be a clear understanding of the Presbyterian governance system.

What specific tasks, assignments, and program areas will this person have responsibility?

- Leading the congregation in weekly worship, providing meaningful sermons to a mature congregation
- Performing administration duties associated with, as well as providing Elder guidance regarding, Session and congregational meetings
- Assisting the congregation in meeting its stated mission and vision goals, including the bringing in of new members
- Promoting evangelism in concert with the Session
- Overseeing the Christian Education program in concert with the Session
- Working in harmony with the Director of Music
- Providing, in concert with the Session, pastoral care to all members and active friends of the church
